

COACHING FOR MINISTRY AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL YEAR *(For Navigator staff coaching volunteer leaders)*

Foundations

Identify stage of ministry:

New: first efforts on this campus
Building: some previous efforts that have had impact
Mature: reproducing ministry

Pray for all aspects of the ministry.

Clearly identify key leader(s) and their spiritual development needs.

Brainstorm on things you might do with key leader(s).

Leader Development

Schedule a meeting with the volunteer leader(s) you are coaching (allowing a minimum of three hours) to discuss the following:

The Navigator Calling, Values, and Vision
The volunteer leader's spiritual growth needs
The staff coach's vision for the leader's development
The volunteer leader's vision for the campus
Potential ministry partners

The main outcome of this meeting will be a specific plan for helping to meet the leader's spiritual growth needs.

Ministry Development

Join with leader for on-site prayer for the campus.

Determine who is interested in affiliating in any capacity (leadership, Bible study).

Determine what events and activities will best meet the spiritual needs of those involved in the ministry.

Determine where the volunteer leader will focus his or her efforts (meeting one to one, leading a Bible study, meeting new freshmen, etc).
